- Additional fees are charged on a grade by grade basis for items such as technology supplies, curriculum-based field trips, grade camps, etc.
- Invoices are sent to families by the end of April, or are sent as part of the Admissions offer.
- Tuition and other fees are approved by the Board of Governors on an annual basis. Updated fee information is published each February.

Additional Discounts and Charges:

1. Sibling Discount

The school has a progressive sibling discount: the eldest child currently enrolled incurs full fees; the second child currently enrolled is entitled to a 5% tuition fee reduction; the third and any other children currently enrolled are entitled to a 10% tuition fee reduction.

2. New Student Fees

- a) Due at the time of application: \$250 non-refundable Application Fee
- b) Due at the time of acceptance: \$2,000 non-refundable Registration Fee

3. Other Expenses:

a) Uniforms:

Required school uniform items must be purchased on campus at the school store. Uniform expenses are approximately \$200 to \$400.

b) School Supplies Fee:

School Supplies Fee is \$35.

c) After School Care:

After School Care is available throughout the school year from 3:20 p.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday to Friday for Junior School students. The cost for After School Care is \$23 per day.

Tuition Refund Plan:

The Tuition Refund Plan provides an opportunity for a partial refund of tuition fees if your child is unable to complete the academic year for one of the following reasons:

1. Death, Absence or Withdrawal for Medical Reasons:
 - a) 100% of the unused fees (prorated for every class day lost), provided the medical disability certified by a legally qualified physician or surgeon extends for thirty-one or more consecutive days.
2. Non-medical Withdrawal or Dismissal:
 - a) Withdrawal due to family relocation: 65% of the unused fees (prorated for every school day lost).
 - b) Dismissal: 65% of the unused fees (prorated for every school day lost).

NOTE: Withdrawals for transferring to other schools are not covered under this plan and no refund is provided in these instances.

The cost of the Tuition Refund Plan (TRP) is 2% of Tuition Fees (less any applicable scholarships, bursaries, or sibling discounts). The TRP is **mandatory** for students paying monthly or in installments (see below) and is included in the 10 monthly payments outlined above. It is **optional** for students whose school fees are paid in full by May 31, 2019. If the TRP fee is not paid by May 31, 2019, the school will not refund any of the unused tuition fees in the event you notify the school of your child's departure after this date.

Payment Options and Methods:

Fees are payable in advance for the year on May 31, 2019. Fees paid in full by May 31 will avoid any finance charge. The fee payment options available are:

- a) Payment in full by May 31, 2019.
- b) 10 Monthly post-dated cheques, May 31, 2019 through March 1, 2020.
- c) 10 Monthly payments through pre-authorized debits (PADs), May 31, 2019 through March 1, 2020.

GNS can accept the following payment methods:

- Pre-authorized debit (Canadian financial institution)
- Canadian or US cash
- Cheque or money order
- Online banking at any major Canadian financial institution
- Direct wire transfer
- Credit card (plus a 3% administration fee)

Volunteerism and Philanthropy:

Fundraising is an important and ongoing component of GNS. Funds to support developing programs and capital expansion come from donations and from fundraising events. It is understood that Parents/Guardians of children enrolled in GNS become members of the GNS family 'community,' which is committed to the support of and participation in fundraising activities, without which we could not achieve the high standards we have set for the school.

GNS also thrives with the volunteer assistance from Parents/Guardians and friends. For new parents to the school, a member of our Advancement Team will be in touch with you to explain the different ways families are involved in philanthropy at GNS.
